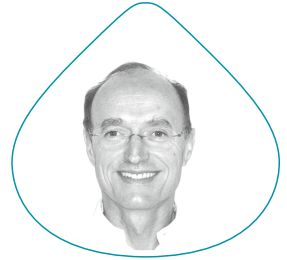
- How to make an accurate periodontal diagnosis to prevent the loss of tissues that occurs after extraction
- Evaluation of soft and hard tissues: attached gingiva, bone defect (open and close defect, number of residual walls, notion of critical size defect)
- Soft tissues management: grafting techniques (surface graft, embedded connective tissue graft, pedicle flap, Muco-graft)
- Immediate placement of implants: indications, contra-indications, technique
- Reconstruction of the socket: how to use biomaterials and membranes
- Interest of osteosynthesis screws

Workshops

- Gingival grafts on animal models
 - Free gingival graft and embedded connective tissue graft increasing attached gingiva
 - Laterally positioned flap on a gingival recession
- Adjust a night guard
- Immediate placement of implants on models
 - Socket reconstruction with biomaterials and membranes on models
